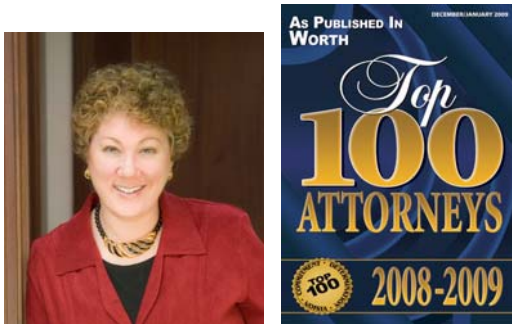

## EDEN ROSE BROWN NAMED ONE OF NATION'S TOP LAWYERS

*Salem, OR* – For the third consecutive year, *Worth* magazine has named Salem native Eden Rose Brown to its annual list of the Top 100 Attorneys in America.
